The Providence Branch of the English-Speaking Union offers the

ELISHA MOWRY-BRIDGHAM AWARD

of \$1500 in a competition open to sophomores and juniors concentrating in any humanities discipline at colleges and universities in Rhode Island. Applicants must be planning to study in the United Kingdom or Ireland for a portion of their junior year, or, in the case of current juniors, during the summer after their junior year.

There are no application forms. Letters of application should (1) give evidence of serious intent in a specific field of study (2) state where the applicant intends to study in the UK or Ireland and (3) include the applicant's present address and telephone number, and fax or email address if available. Applicants must also provide a transcript from their current college or university and three letters of recommendation, preferably from persons familiar with their academic work, to be sent by the referees separately to the committee. All correspondence should be addressed to the chairman, Prof. Peter S. Allen, 44 Oriole Avenue, Providence, RI 02906-5528 and posted so as to arrive no later than Monday, April 19th, 2010.

In the past the Elisha Mowry-Bridgham Award has been made to students from Brown University, Providence College, Rhode Island College, Roger Williams University, and Salve Regina University. While abroad, the holder of the Award will have the opportunity to meet members of the British or Irish Branches of the English-Speaking Union.
